## SPRING

- 1. Check for Damp and Mold
  - Inspect for Winter Damage: Look for signs of mold or damp caused by winter weather. Check walls, ceilings, and windows for any moisture issues.
  - Ventilation: Ensure your home is well-ventilated after winter. Open windows regularly to reduce indoor humidity.
  - Check Behind Furniture: Inspect areas behind furniture for hidden mold or damp damage.
- 2. Garden Maintenance
  - Prepare the Soil: Clear debris and prepare soil for planting. Add compost to enrich the soil.

## SUMMER

- 1. Prevent Insects and Pests
  - Keep Gaps Sealed: Use screens or seal gaps to prevent insects from entering your home.
  - Control Outdoor Pests: Use insect repellents or natural pest control methods in your garden.
- 2. Garden Care
  - Water Regularly: Ensure plants are watered consistently, especially during hot spells.
    Water early in the morning or late in the evening to minimize evaporation.
  - Weed Control: Regularly remove weeds in the garden and pathway/driveways
  - Check Garden Structures: Inspect fences and garden structures for damage. Look behind trees and bushes to assess their condition.

#### AUTUMN

- 1. Prepare for Winter
  - Check Heating Systems: Ensure your heating system is working efficiently. Report any issues for timely repairs.
  - Inspect for Drafts: Check windows and doors for drafts and seal any gaps to retain heat.
  - Check and Clean Gutters: If accessible, check gutters for blockages and clean them out to prevent issues from leaves and moss.
  - Check Locks: Ensure all locks are functioning properly and not becoming stiff in the cold.
    Address any issues before temperatures drop further.
  - Trim Overgrown Plants: Trim bushes and trees to prevent them from becoming unmanageable. Avoid heavy pruning during nesting season or hire a professional if necessary.
- 2. Garden Maintenance
  - Clear Leaves and Debris: Rake up fallen leaves and debris to prevent mold and pests.

#### WINTER

- 1. Manage Condensation and Mold
  - Monitor Humidity: Use a dehumidifier if necessary to manage indoor humidity levels.
